Prizes:

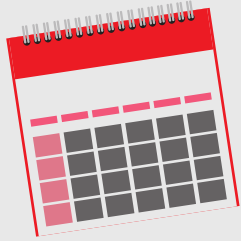
-The HOG Member with the highest overall
